ARCHDIOCESE OF CARDIFF INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT CATHOLIC SECONDARY SCHOOL -- NORMAL SIZE

- The name of the school is St Joseph's Roman Catholic High School
- The school was founded by and is part of the Catholic Church. The school is to be conducted as a Catholic School in accordance with the canon law and teachings of the Roman Catholic Church, and in accordance with the Trust Deed of the Archdiocese of Cardiff and in particular:
 - religious education is to be in accordance with the teachings, doctrines, discipline and general and particular norms of the Catholic Church;
 - religious worship is to be in accordance with the rites, practices, discipline and liturgical norms of the Catholic Church;

and at all times the school is to serve as a witness to the Catholic faith in our Lord Jesus Christ.

- The school is a voluntary aided school.
- The name of the governing body is: The Governing Body of St Joseph's Roman Catholic High School

The governing body shall consist of:

- (a) twelve foundation governors (except at any time when the head teacher has given notice that he chooses not to be a governor, when the number of foundation governors will be eleven).
- (b) three parent governors;
- (c) two LEA governors;
- (d) two teacher governors;
- (e) one staff governor;
- (f) the head teacher (except at any time when (s)he has given written notice to the clerk to the governing body of the school that (s)he chooses not to be a governor).
- Total number of governors: twenty-one (except at any time when the head teacher has given notice as above that (s)he chooses not to be a governor, when the total number of governors will be nineteen).
- Foundation governors are appointed and may be removed by the Archbishop of Cardiff (or any other person exercising Ordinary jurisdiction on his behalf).
- If there is any excess in the number of foundation governors, the person named in paragraph 7
 above shall remove sufficient foundation governors to ensure that such excess is eliminated.
- Subject to Part 5 of The Government of Maintained Schools (Wales) Regulations 2005 this
 instrument of government comes into effect on the 1 January 2008 for the purpose of
 reconstituting the governing body.
