Re: Provisional Centre-Determined Grades and decision making record

I am sure that you have been eager to receive your provisional Centre-Determined Grades (CDGs) for your GCSEs, A levels and for your Skills Challenge Certificates. Please find the attached decision making record which lists your provisional CDGs and how the grades have been determined.

Please remember:

- these grades are provisional until results are published on 10 August for Years 12 and 13 and 12 August for Years 10 and 11.
- grades for vocational qualifications and qualifications under English exam boards will not be shared until results are published on 10 and 12 August.

The review/appeal process for 2021

As examinations have been cancelled this year, the appeals process is very different. Qualifications Wales sent out information about this process which I shared with you in my last letter. If you would like to remind yourself of this information, please click here.

In summary, there are three stages of this review/appeal process:

Stage 1: Centre review, undertaken by the school

Stage 2: WJEC review, undertaken by WJEC

Stage 3: EPRS review, undertaken by Qualifications Wales

Each stage of the review process must be completed before moving on to the next stage.

When to request a review/appeal

This year, you can request a review **if you believe that an error has been made when determining your grade**. You need to remember that a grade can go up, or go down or stay the same as a result of the review.

Examples of what could be an error in the determination of a grade:

- access arrangements or special consideration were not taken into consideration
- evidence which should have been considered has not been considered
- the grade is not supported by the information in the decision making record

If you require any further information to help you decide whether to request a review, you need to email me at imorgan@sjhs.newport.sch.uk by 4pm on Friday 25 June to request the information you need.

If you want to request a review of your CDG, you will need to complete the attached form, entitled, 'Stage 1 Centre Review and appeals request form' and email the form to me at imorgan@sjhs.newport.sch.uk by 4pm on Friday 2 July.

Finding out the outcome of the review

I will then undertake a review of the process and documentation which has led to your CDG in that subject and will inform you of the outcome before the end of term. When you are sent the outcome of the review, you will also be sent information regarding how to apply for a Stage 2 review if you are unhappy with the outcome of Stage 1.

If you are studying a subject in a school other than your home school and need to request a review

If you are studying a subject as part of our Newport West collaboration, please email your home school with the form (attached). Your home school will then pass on your request to the teaching school who will undertake the review. The outcome of the review will then be sent to your home school to be shared with you.

As detailed above, you will need to ask for any additional information you may need by **4pm on Friday 25 June.**

You will need to submit your request for a review to your home school by 4pm on Friday 2 July.

Requesting a review in August for Ofqual qualifications

For the qualifications under Ofqual, when you receive your grades on 10 or 12 August, you will have an opportunity to request a review if you believe that an error has been made. I will send out further information about this which you will receive with your published results.
