Dear Parents/Carers,

We are really excited to welcome your child back to school on Monday 28th September. The Year 8 zone has lacked the buzz and warmth of the pupils.

Since Year 8 went home on Thursday 17th September, the Year 8 classrooms and corridors have had a deep clean. This week, the Year 8 pastoral team have been making 'keeping in touch' phone calls to our families. Staff in school have also ensured that work has been set on Google Classroom following the school's FLPs (Fortnightly Learning Plan). Please can I remind you that pupils will be expected:

- Pupils must also wear their masks in communal areas of the school including the corridors and toilets.
