### Re: Year 11 Revision booklet and guidance

I have been so impressed with the level of effort and work from the Year 11 students. I want to thank you for your ongoing effort to support your son/daughter in making such a positive start to their final GCSE year.

Between 12<sup>th</sup> May and 20<sup>th</sup> June 2023, your son/daughter will be sitting their final GCSE examinations.
