The report itself reflects the hard work and dedication of our staff and highlights the positive attitudes and conscientious efforts of you, our amazing pupils, of whom we are so proud.

The report states that St Joseph's is 'a caring and inclusive community underpinned by a strong culture of kindness and respect.'

Our sixth form students are highlighted: 'Nearly all pupils in the sixth form have a positive attitude to their studies. They contribute willingly to class discussions and demonstrate enthusiasm for learning.'

Opportunities for pupils to influence school development is reflected in the report: 'Pupil leadership activities have a positive impact on provision and pupil wellbeing. Pupils' views are sought and acted upon, and many pupils feel their voice is valued.'
