Re: Summer uniform consultation

You will be aware that, over the last several months, we have been speaking with students, parents, carers, staff, and governors about changes to our summer uniform policy. These changes have been made in response to feedback from students, with the aim of making expectations around uniform clearer and more consistent during warmer weather conditions.

What are the changes? Following that consultation period, the following changes to the policy have been agreed by the Governing Body:

Pupils in Years 7 to 11

In the summer term only, pupils have the option of wearing grey tailored shorts instead of grey trousers or skirt. In addition, **in the summer term only**, pupils have the option to wear their white and red school PE T-shirt instead of shirt, tie and blazer. GCSE PE students have the option to wear their red school PE shirt.

Sixth Form students

In the summer term only, students have the option of wearing black tailored shorts instead of black trousers or skirt.

The change to the uniform policy will begin on Monday 1st June 2026 and will remain in place until the end of the summer term.

The summer uniform is an alternative to the standard school uniform. If students would prefer to continue wearing the standard uniform, they are still welcome to do so.

Uniform expectations

We would also like to remind students that our expectations around uniform remain the same, whichever option is worn. After half-term, there will be a renewed focus on ensuring all students are wearing the correct uniform every day and continuing to represent the school positively.
