Has your company ever offered an Apprenticeship?

- Mainly we offer Trades Apprenticeships Carpenter, Electrician, Painter, Gardener. Sometimes we have one off roles such as HR, Finance and Admin.
- What piece of advice would you offer to a student considering an apprenticeship?
- Recruiting an Apprentice is about attitude, values and work ethic. So it's harder for a company to identify these things compared to experience, knowledge and skills.
- So try and stand out. If you've manged to pick up work experience/Sat job great.
- You also need to research the company showing how you are genuinely interested in what you see on their website. Always learn their values and show how you live them.
- Where do you advertise your apprenticeship vacancies?
- On Carers Wales, but also our website. Always go to a companies website and sign up for email alerts.
 You and select Apprenticeships and when a vacancy is posted it will be delivered straight to your inbox.
- Would you encourage students to send you speculative letters if you are not advertising vacancies at this time?
- Afraid not. Unless there is a real vacancy there's nowhere to store it so you'll be referred to sign up for e-mail alerts.
 Some larger companies have Talent pools where they will be able to save your request. So it may work for some.






