

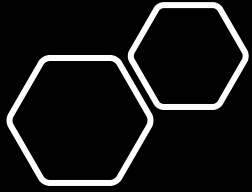

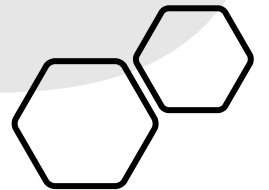
Use this event to help with the following;
