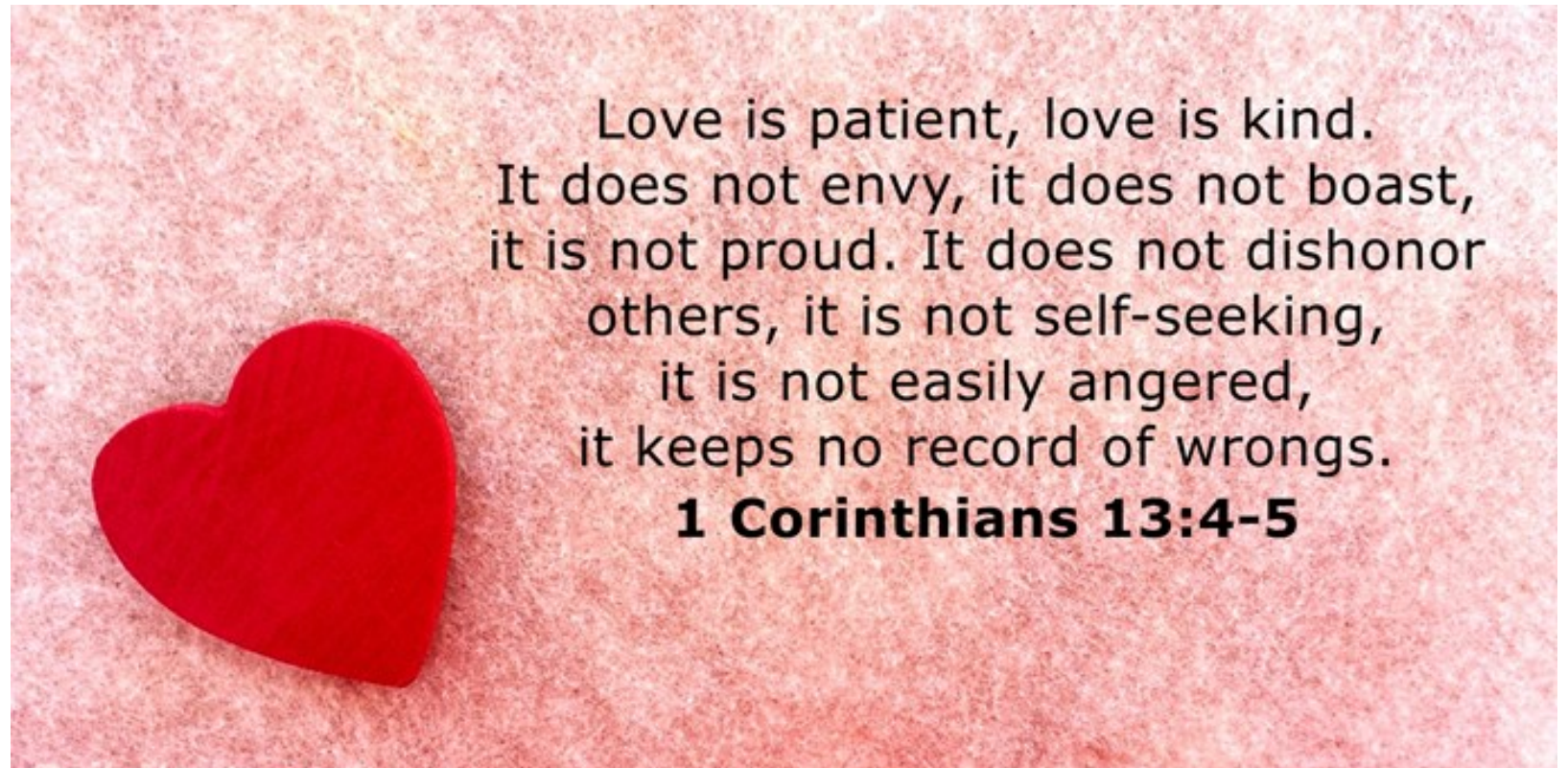
- As we come together again in our form, year group, school community or family at home, let us pause and be available to reflect.

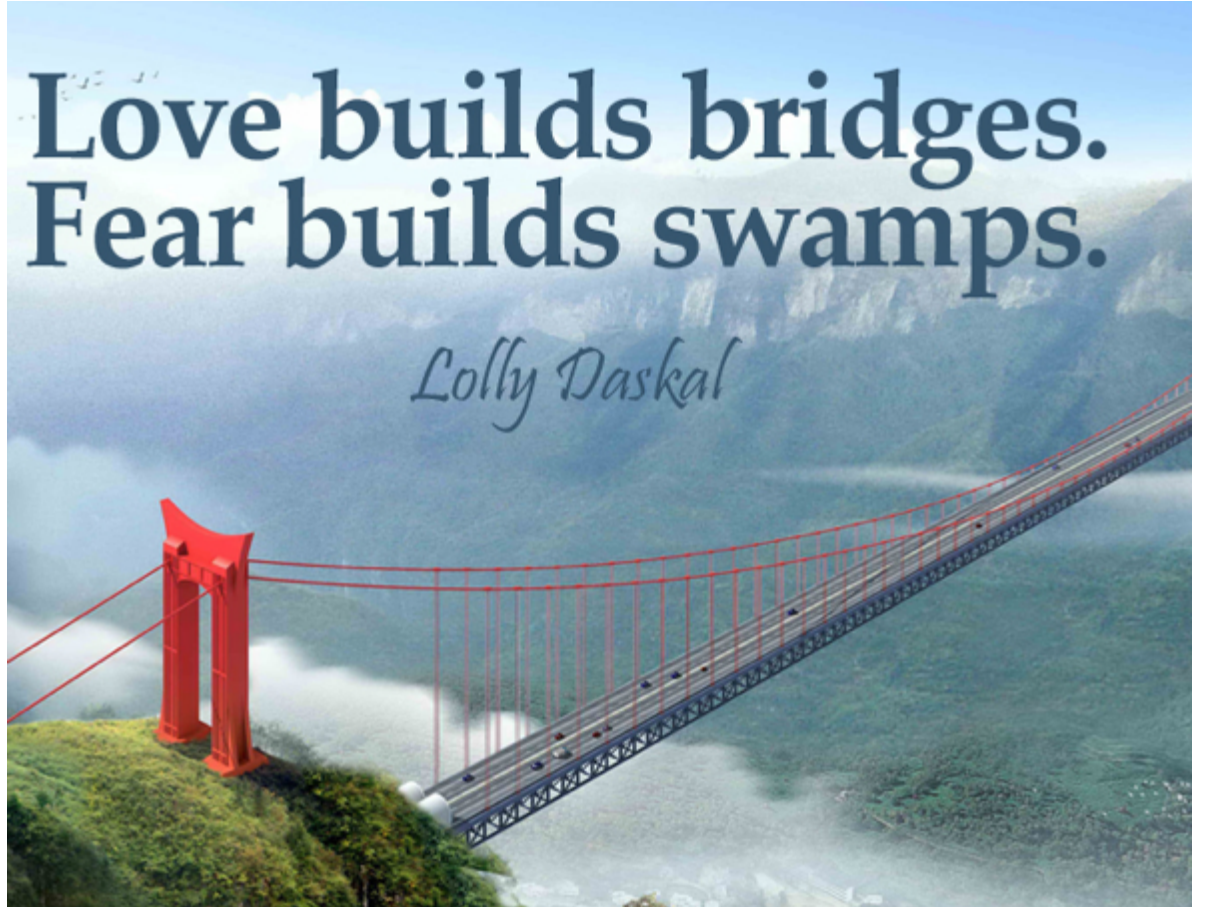
